We are Back Making Music!

Finally, after the many closures of 2020 Calos has been lucky enough to re-start in-person rehearsals. Our first session, Oct. 18 at the Christian Victory Centre was a great start and we are grateful them for hosting us.



In the last week of October, we were lucky to partner with Martek Morgan-Finch and secure three rehearsal spaces. All spaces are equipped with ample natural and artificial lighting, high ceilings and proper air circulation systems.



Starting Nov. 1 we also extended rehearsal to 120 minutes, a sectional time of approx. 50 minutes (using three spaces) and then a full orchestra rehearsal of 60 minutes, in the main location.

We were so happy with the space on that we decided to conduct weekly rehearsals of 120 minutes and postpone all Zoom rehearsals until such a time that we are required return to online.



A new schedule will be sent via email. All musicians must continue to pre-register on-line (using a new Gov. NL questionnaire this week.)
