Year Start Up

Welcome back to all our families. And a special welcome to our newest CALOS musicians and families. We hope you have a great season in Orchestra.

This year we are pleased to see the return of both our Junior Strings and Junior Winds Ensembles, our Junior Orchestra and Senior Orchestra. In the winter-spring we also hope to return to our smaller playing ensembles, with one performang a pre-show for "Au Revoir" on May 10, which marks the final performance of NSO's Maestro, Marc David.

As with last season, CALOS Junior Winds and Strings will rehearse in sectionals from 2:30 – 3:15 with the full Orchestra rehearsal from 3:30 – 4:15 weekly. Senior Orchestra rehearsal is from 2:30 – 5:15 with a scheduled break in between. We would ask all musicians to please check in and warm up starting at 2:15 so that the batons can drop on time at 2:30 pm.


Fall Concert 2024

At the current moment, both CALOS Junior and Senior are preparing for our Dec. 1 concert at D. F. Cook Recital Hall, at MUN's School of Music. This concert, entitled *L'eau*, marks a celebration of water inspired music. In November, Mandy will be in touch with an online form where all families can purchase tickets in advance. In the past season, approximately 90% of our tickets sales occurred prior to the concert as we are only able to offer a cash service for door sales. Families can order their advance tickets via electronic transfer, cheque or cash (at rehearsal). Typically, tickets are delivered to musicians to take home from the last two rehearsals before a concert.

We also hope that during concert time, our Board will sponsor a 50/50 ticket draw. More details will be forth coming after the November Board meeting. All proceeds of the draw are to support the CALOS Bursary and Instrument Lending funds.

This season we have been very lucky to have acquired a Government of NL Infrastructure & Programs grant to commission a water-inspired "Suite" by local composer, Jim Duff. It is hoped



that the Senior

Concert. We are
delighted that Mr. Duff
will be present in some
of our November
rehearsals as we
continue to work on the
composition.

This concert will mark the end of our rehearsal process until January 5, 2025 when we return to our regularly scheduled rehearsals.
